A submission release form must be signed and returned along with your application.

If you are submitting a script for development refinement and polishing, it is your responsibility to insure it is properly formatted and up to industry standards. Any scripts that are improperly formatted or filled with typographical and spelling errors will immediately be turned down. This requirement allows us to focus on the work itself, the character development, plot and storylines.

Fees must be paid up front.

Appointments must be honored. Last-minute cancellations cannot be made up unless in case of emergency. If an appointment cannot be met, 48 hour advance notice is required in order to reschedule.
